The simple formula which is used for any major scale:

One- One- Zero- One-One- One-Zero (1-1-0-1-1-0)

What do you mean by Ones and Zeros?

Oneâ??s (whole step) â?? If there is a one key between two notes, then the interval of those two notes is One.

Eg: from B to C# the interval is a??one keya?•

Zeroâ??s (half step) â?? If there are no keys or zero keys between two notes, then the interval of those two notes is Zero

Eg: from D# to E the interval is â??zeroâ?• (Immediate keys)
