## What do you mean by Ones and Zeros?

Oneâ??s (whole step) â?? If there is a one key between two notes, then the interval of those two notes is One.

Eg: from C# to D# the interval is a??one keya?•

**Zeroâ??s** (half step) â?? If there are no keys or zero keys between two notes, then the interval of those two notes is Zero

Eg: from F to F# the interval is a??zeroa?• (Immediate keys)
