



## "G#/Ab" Major Scale Positions - Piano Tutorials

Notes: G#-1, A#-2, C-3, C#-4, D#-5, F-6, G-7, G#-8

Since it is a 'G#' major scale obviously 'G#' will be first note, how to find the remaining notes ?

The simple formula which is used for any major scale:

One- One- Zero- One-One- One-Zero (1-1-0-1-1-1-0)

### What do you mean by Ones and Zeros ?

**One's (whole step)** – If there is a one key between two notes, then the interval of those two notes is One.

Eg: from G# to A# the interval is "one key"

**Zero's (half step)** – If there are no keys or zero keys between two notes, then the interval of those two notes is Zero

Eg: from C to C# the interval is "zero" (Immediate keys)
